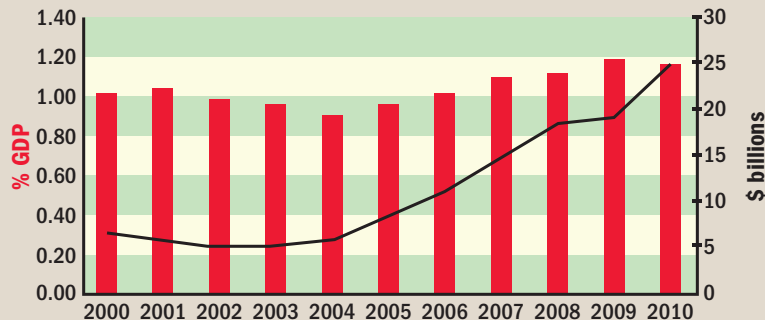


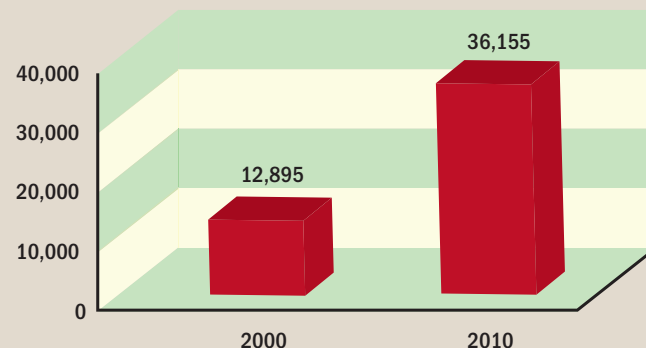
R&D expenditure

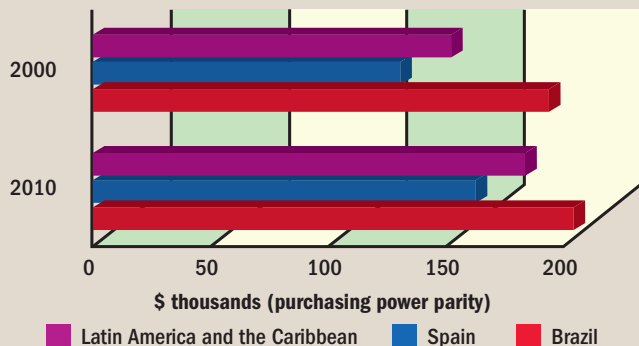

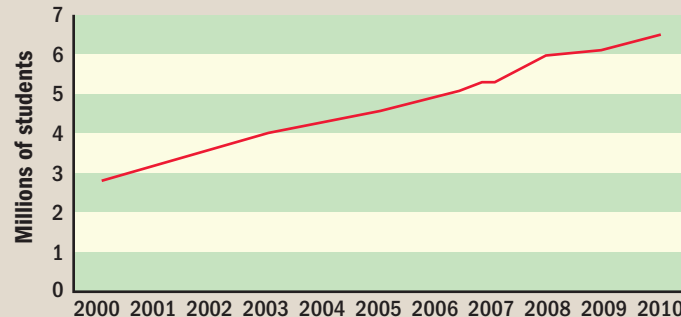
R&D expenditure per researcher
