The University has strong partnerships with Lomonosov Moscow State University (the Russian Federation), Al-Farabi Kazakh National University, M.Auezov South Kazakhstan State University, Silkway International University (the Republic of Kazakhstan) and Osh State University (the Kyrgyz Republic) in the field of academic mobility of students.

The University implements 12 joint educational programs with Holon Institute of Technology (Israel), Lomonosov Moscow State University, Tomsk State University, Kazan Federal University, Financial University under the Government of the Russian Federation (the Russian Federation) and International Sakharov Environmental Institute of Belarusian State University (the Republic of Belarus). Negotiations are underway to open joint educational programs with Belarusian National Technical University, Russian State Hydrometeorological University and M.Auezov South Kazakhstan State University.

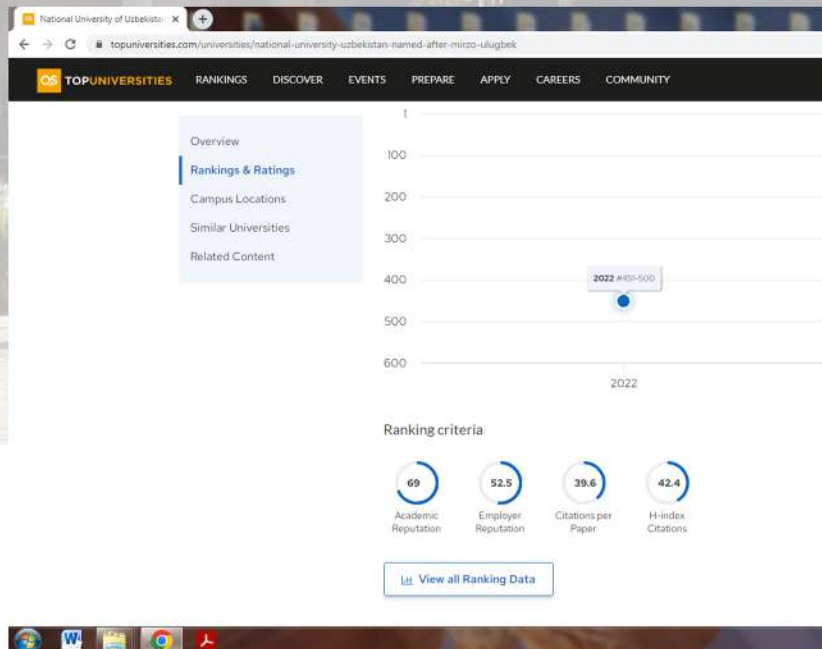

more than 3 000 publications in scientific journals included in
the international database Scopus and Web of Science.

Education

National University of Uzbekistan, being the flagship of the higher education system of the country, has all necessary conditions to ensure educational process at the highest level.

The university has a full-time, part-time (evening classes from 18:00 to 20:50) extramural and distance (online) forms of study.

Duration of study in a undergraduate programs for full-time form of study - 4 academic years, for part-time - 4,5 academic years, for extramural and distance form of study - 5 academic years.

Graduate programs are designed for 1 and 2 academic years, Postgraduate (PhD and DSc) programs - 3 years.



Accommodation

For comfortable studying of foreign citizens at NUU, the university has a special dormitory for foreign students near the study campus.

The dormitory is provided to foreign students **free of charge**. For the safety of the students, the dormitory is under surveillance 24 hours a day.

There are grocery stores, clinic, subway station, banks and restaurants within a radius of 200 metres from the dormitory.





Leisure

Foreign students, in their free time, take active participation in holidays, cultural events, and conferences taking place at the University.

Also, the University has a modern information and resource center where anyone can find the necessary literature for learning or pleasant pastime.

Admission

Foreign citizens enter NUU without passing entrance exams, only on the basis of an interview.

For admission, you must provide to the Department of International Students Affairs (in person or via e-mail intdep@nuu.uz or intdepnuu@gmail.com) the following documents:

1. Completed application form (can be downloaded from nuu.uz)
2. Certificate or diploma of secondary education (for applicants to bachelor's degree)
Bachelor's degree diploma (for applicants to master's degree) translated to english, uzbek or russian.
3. Passport
4. Medical certificate
