Scholarships

The University of La Verne offers competitive merit scholarships to all qualified international undergraduate applicants. Scholarships are awarded based upon the applicant's GPA. Additional scholarships are available for on-campus housing and meals.

3. Transcripts

Unofficial transcripts can be submitted for admission consideration, but final official transcripts need to come directly from your school once you graduate (visit univ.lv/international for more details on transcript guidance).

4. Application fee (\$50)
5. Letter of recommendation
6. Proof of English proficiency (visit univ.lv/international for more details)
